Trick or Treasure Guidelines

We hope you will join us for a SPOOKTACULAR good time at the FINest Halloween event in town! We are so grateful for your support in making a truly special memory for Utah families during our “Trick or Treasure” event.

Date	Hours
Trick or Treasure Monday, October 28 4:00-8 pm Booths must remain staffed until 8 pm.	All trick or treasure booths must be staffed and show-ready 15 minutes early. You may check-in as early as 3:00 pm and begin setup at 3:30 pm. Carts are recommended for moving your supplies from car to booth.

Candy

Please bring as much candy/swag as you are able.

Candy must be:

- Individually wrapped
- 25% of the candy options must be chocolate-based
- Made with sustainably-sourced products, such as [palm oil](#) (see attached guides)

Candy must NOT be:

- Penny candy (i.e. starlight mints, butterscotch disks, strawberry buds)
- A choking hazard (hard, small candies)
- Homemade

Booths cannot be left unattended at any point during the event. Please coordinate to have one of your team monitoring your booth and candy at all times.

What to Bring with You

Please bring one (1) table (6-8 ft) and chairs according to your needs.

In addition to the candy and optional costumes, you are invited to bring the following:

- Bowls or baskets for giving out candy
- Decorations for your booth/table (see below)
- Battery powered decorative lights or electronics (power will not be provided, some areas will be dark or dim with event lighting)
- Scissors, tape, easels, string or anything you need to attach items to a table
- Promotional signage and/or giveaways
- Cart or wagon for transporting from car to building (the Aquarium will not provide any)

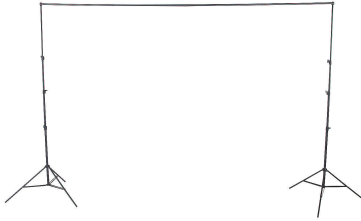
Decorations and Costumes

Decorating your booth and dressing up as a team is a great way to show the community your Halloween spirit! This year’s theme is pirates, mermaids, and sea animals. We encourage groups to decorate and wear costumes to match the theme.

Decorations cannot be attached to Aquarium walls. You are encouraged to bring frames or backdrops to increase the decorative possibilities (see examples on the next page.) Your footprint should not exceed 10 ft wide or 5 ft deep. Decorations/costumes must be rated "G" or "PG" and cannot include the following:

- Gore, blood, scary elements
- Inappropriate, adult, or lewd décor

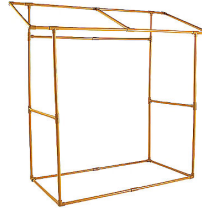

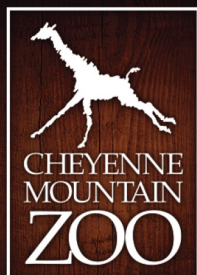

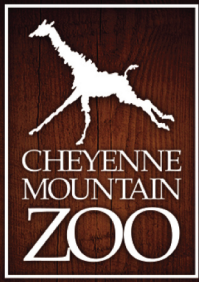
